

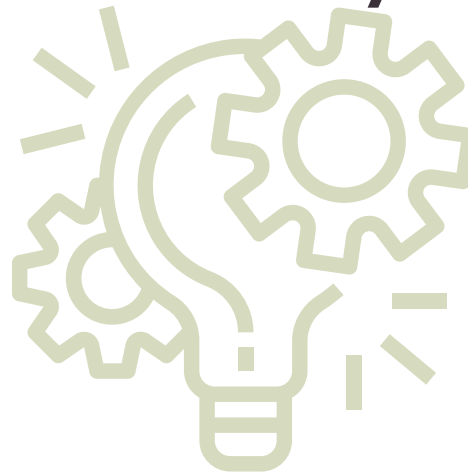


Internship Boot Camp

What is an internship?

An internship is any carefully monitored, meaningful learning experience with an employer in which an individual has intentional professional goals and reflects actively on what he or she is accomplishing throughout the experience.

Internships are comprised of...

- 3-4 Hard skills learned
- 3-4 Essential skills learned
- Planning and completing an internship project of the student's choice
- Final reflection project

Internships generally take place over 12 weeks, but we can be flexible.

You choose where you want to intern with the support of a RISE employee. Then, you work with your supervisor to make a schedule and goals that works best for the both of you!

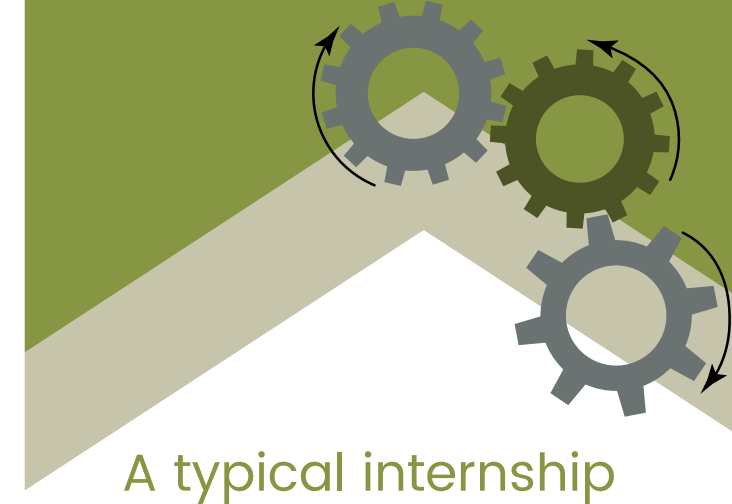
Who is the internship for?

Anyone 16 years of age or older at any of our seven partner schools. This includes, Monte Vista, Sargent, Center, Mountain Valley, Sierra Grande, South Conejos and Alamosa.

Will my internship be paid?

The RISE grant does not offer paid internships, but you will receive a stipend for your training and hours worked. Elective college credit at ASU is also free!

50 hrs	2 credits available	\$362.50

A typical internship

- ⇒ Includes developing intentional learning objective goals that are structured into the experience and supervised by a professional with relevant and related background in the field.
- ⇒ Promotes academic, career and/or personal development.
- ⇒ Includes learning objectives, observation, reflection, and evaluation.
- ⇒ Balances the intern's learning goals with the organization's needs.
- ⇒ Typically lasts three months. May be part-time or full-time.
- ⇒ Involves industry related hard skill and essential skill (soft skill) development.
- ⇒ May be carefully monitored and evaluated for academic credit.
- ⇒ Provides adequate supervision in a reasonably safe environment with the necessary tools to perform the learning goals agreed upon for the duration of the internship.
