

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Education of the Sierra Grande School District has declared a vacancy for Director District #3 that will be filled by appointment by the Board in accordance with the following procedure:

1. Interested persons are invited to send a formal written request statement to Mr. Walter Roybal, President of Sierra Grande Board of Education, Sierra Grande School District 17523 Hwy. 160 Blanca, CO 81123. Written request may also be submitted in a sealed envelope to the district office and must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, December 8, 2021.
2. The Board will interview prospective candidates on Monday, December 13th, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at a public meeting.
3. To be eligible for appointment, a candidate must be a registered elector of the school district and a resident of Director District #3 in which the vacancy exists. The candidate must be a registered voter for at least 12 consecutive months prior to the election. No person who has been convicted of a sexual offense against a child is eligible to serve on the school board. Because school director elections are nonpartisan, candidates may not campaign as members of a political party.
4. Boundaries of District #3 are as follows: (see also attached map of Director Districts)

Beginning at the intersection point of Juarez Road with the south section line of Section 36, Township 31 South, Range 72 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian,

Thence westerly along the south section lines of Section 36, 35, 34, 33 and 32 to the southwest corner of Section 32, Township 31 South, Range 72 West (or to the intersection with the east line of Smith Lane)

Then northerly along the west section lines of Sections 32, 29, 20, 17, 8 and 5 in Township 31 South, Range 72 West and Sections 32, 39, 1nd 20 in Township 30 South, Range 72 West (or the east line of Smith Lane) to the intersection with the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 160,

Then easterly along the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 160 to the intersection with the west section line of Section 21, Township 30 South, Range 72 West,

Then northerly along the west section line of Section 21, Township 30 South, Range 72 West to the intersection with a straight line extended easterly to the south line of Fifth Avenue in the Town of Fort Garland,

Thence easterly along the line extended to Fifth Avenue in the Town of Fort Garland and continuing along the south line of Fifth Avenue to its intersection with the alleyway east of Miranda Avenue,

Thence southward along the centerline of the alleyway east of Miranda Avenue extended southward on a straight line to its intersection with the center line of the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad right of way,

Thence easterly along said center line of the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad right-of-way to its intersection with the west line of the Trinchera Ranch Road,

Thence southeasterly along the west line of Trinchera Ranch Road, the west line of County Lane 6, and the west line of Juarez Road to its intersection with the south section line of Section 36, Township 31 South, Range 72 West, same being the place of beginning.

5. The appointee will serve until the next regular school biennial election in November 2023 at which time an election will be held for a successor to fill the remainder of the unexpired term.
