

Early Access Timeline

By February 1st

Parents interested in exploring Early Access for their child contact their local district. At that time the local district provides parent contact information to the San Luis Valley BOCES G/T Coordinator. The San Luis Valley BOCES G/T Coordinator contacts the parents and explains the program and provides the parents with the Information Packet.

By February 15th

Parent returns Information Packet to San Luis Valley BOCES G/T Coordinator

By March 15th

Conduct initial Data Gathering Interview with parents, BOCES GT Coordinator, District GT Coordinator or principal and school psychologist
GT/RTI second meeting to analyze data to reach a decision about proceeding in the process

By April 1st

School RTI Team and G/T Team Meeting (by 4/1) Analyze Data to Reach Decision to Pursue Further Testing (located at local school)

By May 1st

Determination Meeting (by 5/1) Attending: GT RTI team:
Evaluation of achievement and aptitude assessments
Reach decision about continuing to early access
(located at local school)
